Renowned neurologist and leading Alzheimer's and dementia expert, Dr. Douglas Scharre is a professor of clinical neurology and psychiatry at The Ohio State University and Director of OSU's Center for Cognitive and Memory Disorders.

In addition to treating patients, Dr. Scharre conducts extensive clinical research in dementia and mild cognitive impairment. He has many active research grants for clinical drug trials, functional neuroimaging studies and screening for mild cognitive impairment and early dementia diagnosis.

Also, Dr. Scharre has written many articles about cognitive neurology and has published extensively on biomarkers in Alzheimer's disease and the treatment of behavioral disturbances in dementia.

One of his most impactful contributions in the area of early detection is the Self-Administered Gerocognitive Exam (SAGE). Used worldwide, SAGE is designed to detect early signs of cognitive, memory or thinking impairments. It evaluates thinking abilities and helps physicians to know how well the brain is working.

Dr. Scharre has served as Medical Director of Ohio Living Ganzhorn Suites since our founding in 2016.
